This step-by-step DVD shows you how easy it is to make your own transfers! You should have a basic working knowledge of the screen printing process before viewing this DVD.

Topics include hot and cold split transfers, sublimation transfers, all about papers and inks, curing and drying, mesh and stencil systems, multi-colour transfers, puff and foil, cap transfers, art requirements and much more.
